Revealed: the winners of the 2025 International Grands Prix for Automotive Innovation!

Paris, September 2025 – The jury of the EQUIP AUTO Paris 2025 International Grands Prix for Automotive Innovation, made up of 100 French and foreign journalists, has reached its verdict. Following a rigorous shortlisting process from among the 166 entries and a final phase of oral presentations by the nominees in early September, the judges designated the winning innovations of this edition that marks the 40th anniversary of the competition.

Since 1985, these Grands Prix have shone a light on the sector's most innovative and effective innovations that bring tangible benefits both to maintenance and



automotive service professionals and to users. In line with previous editions, the awards distinguish technological excellence and accompany the sustainable transformation of the industry. All these innovations will be visible at the exhibition on the stands of each of the winning companies.


